

Our two Ring & Ride buses run five days a week. They visit different places for shopping and days out. The minibuses are fully wheelchair and scooter accessible and have tail lifts.

The bus will collect you from and return you to your door, and the driver will offer assistance with boarding and lifting if required.

You will need to register with us to use this service, and all journeys must be booked in advance.

There are no age restrictions, so no matter how old (or young!) you are, come and enjoy a day out with us.



Our volunteer drivers will collect you from your home, take you to your appointment & wait for you.

The cost is 45p per mile from the driver's house to the destination and return. This money goes only to the drivers to cover their fuel and insurance costs. There is also a £2 booking fee payable to the Office via your driver.

Fold up wheelchairs can be accommodated. We need at least 48hrs notice to book a journey.

For journeys to hospital, if you are on benefits you may be able to claim back some of your travel costs. Contact the hospital for further information.





We provide the Volunteer Car service to help people who are rurally isolated, elderly or who cannot drive and are unable to use public transport.

As a volunteer driver, you are able to help these people to go to attend essential medical appointments.

You would collect the client from their home, take them to their appointment and wait for them before returning home.

Drivers receive 45p/mile for the distance travelled. This is to cover your fuel, road tax and insurance.



No special vehicle or driving license is require, and most insurance companies will cover volunteer work on a normal policy.

We do ask that you take a DBS (Disclosure Bureau Service) check, which we will pay for.

All journeys are booked in advance, and you would accept only trips that are convenient to you. Journeys can vary from only a few miles to as far as Exeter or Plymouth.

We hope you will consider joining our small team. Please contact us for any further information.
